Obligations of the Incorporated Association

The Secretary of an incorporated association is responsible for liaising with Consumer Affairs Victoria (CAV) and lodging the association's annual statement and notifying of any changes.

The role of the Secretary includes:

- lodging an annual statement with CAV within one month after the annual general meeting
- applying to CAV to change association details such as address and roles
- notifying CAV of a special resolution to change the association name, rules, wind up the association or distribute its assets
- dealing with requests to restrict access to information in the association's register of members
- maintain the association's membership register.

If the position of the secretary becomes vacant, it must be filled within 14 days as per the process outlined in the association's rules. CAV must be notified in myCAV within 14 days of the appointment of the new secretary.

Any newly appointed Secretary must access their myCAV account to confirm the accuracy of the Incorporated Association's details and update them if required.
