

## Mid North Coast Flyers – Site Guide

### Harries' Lookout

Ideal wind direction: E-ENE

Site Rating: PG: Novice (if gate open) otherwise Intermediate  
HG: Intermediate w/ Advanced Supervision

Launching: This is a public area so please respect other users of these grounds. The launch is also used for ceremonies. Check the availability on the PMHC calendar <http://venue.pmhc.nsw.gov.au/EPWeb/BookingCalendar/> .

Landing Areas:

Top: Top Landing is not a safe option here.

Main: Shelly Beach below launch. To keep away from the bulk of the public, land north of launch, plenty of beach. Watch out for the rocks below launch on the sand. The beach is large and even when the tide is in on a busy day there are plenty of safe landing options. The beach is easily accessible from either end but there is a car-park, toilets and a stepped walking track to launch to the south.

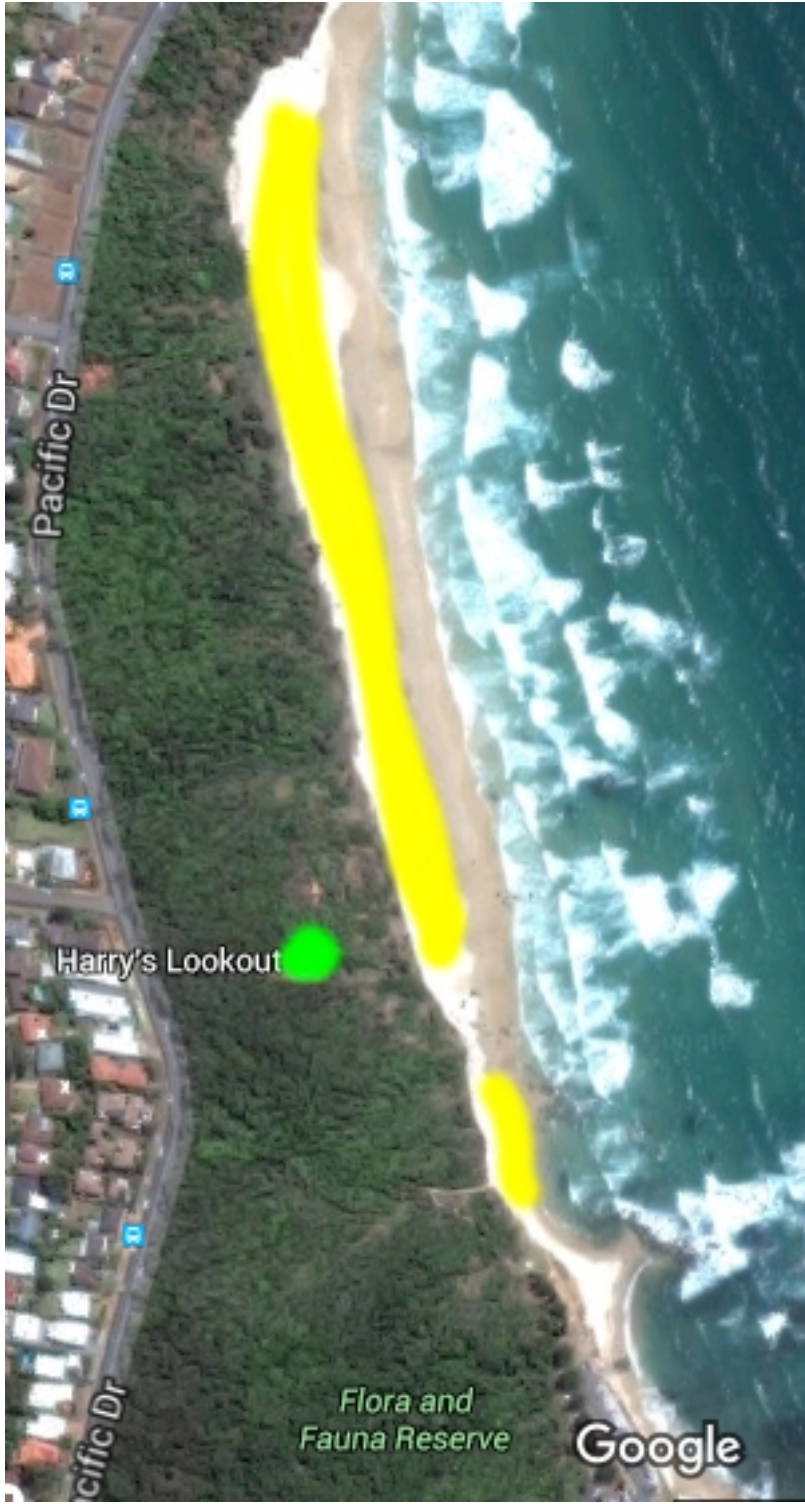
Alt2: None needed.

Hazards: There is a gated fence directly before the cliff edge. C.F.I's have keys to this gate to allow students to launch safely. When the conditions are good the fence can be overflowed easily but never the less presents a hazard. Due to the launch area being 'closed-in' by overgrowth it can be difficult to accurately predict the direction before launch.

If there is a ceremony booked and they are setting up outside of the allotted time slot then please be polite and ask the organisers to allow you to set up and launch.
