



## Local Competitions Subcommittee Member

As a member of the Tamworth Basketball Association (TBA) Local Competitions Subcommittee, you will collaborate with fellow committee members and organisational leadership to play a crucial role in assisting with the organisation and management of local basketball competitions. You will be involved with providing court supervision, overseeing game logistics to ensure smooth operations, ensuring fair play, assisting with the organisation of competitions to promote the growth of the association, resolving disputes, providing care for injuries, and fostering a safe, positive and inclusive environment for everyone involved. The Local Competitions Subcommittee is overseen by the Local Competitions Coordinator, who is a member of the TBA Board.

### Responsibilities:

- Help coordinate local basketball events
- Ensure scheduled games start on time with referees and scoretable personnel present.
- Provide support to referees and officials.
- Maintain a safe and positive environment for players, officials and spectators.
- Provide care for injuries and follow the reporting process if needed.
- Keep teams, coaches, and officials informed as necessary and address concerns promptly.
- Help attract teams and fans to local events, supporting the growth of the sport.
- Gather input from participants to improve future competitions.
- Work closely with fellow subcommittee members to achieve common goals.
- Uphold professionalism and respect while representing TBA.
- Ensure games adhere to basketball rules, intervening when needed.
- Promote and enforce relevant policies and procedures, including but not limited to; TBA Code of Conduct, BNSW Code of Conduct, and Zero Tolerance and Sports Rage Policy.
- Dress appropriately when representing the Association, ensuring attire reflects the professionalism and values of the organisation.

### Required:

- Effective communication with diverse groups.
- Strong problem-solving abilities.
- Handling difficult situations with ease.
- Passion for basketball and community involvement.
- Strong organisation and communication skills.
- Understanding of FIBA Basketball and TBA competition rules, by-laws and regulations.
- Sound understanding of TBA Policies and Procedures, Code of Conduct and Constitution.
- Must have completed the Play by the Rules Safeguarding Children and Anti-doping training modules.
- Completed, or willingness to complete, the BNSW Community Referees and Community Coaches courses.
- Current First Aid Certificate or willingness to obtain.
- Must be a financial member of Tamworth Basketball Association.
- Valid Working with Children Check.

### Time Commitment:

The estimated time commitment for this role will vary depending on factors such as the frequency and duration of competitions, the size of the local basketball community, and specific responsibilities within the committee. Court Supervision is required for up to 5 hours per competition night, some evenings and weekends. This will vary depending on the need of local competition draws. The more Court Supervisors we have, the less time each member will need to invest.

This position will be for a period of up to 12 months and will be declared vacant at the next Tamworth Basketball Association AGM.
