ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current [AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure 5](#) and as per [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.06 SANCTIONING MATRIX \(A\)](#).

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Sprockets & Mini Wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders (Except Participation) must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

MEMBERSHIP

The event will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Discipline or Off-Road Membership.

RACE INFORMATION

RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.05.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing](#).

The race format for the March Madness is as follows:

All Mini Wheelers and Sprockets will receive an award for participation.

CHALLENGE, MASTERS 30+, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, Masters 30+, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Junior Superclass	Prize Money*	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
Superclass	Prize Money^	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
* \$200 prize pool per round (50:50 split male / female), plus 100% payback		
^ \$800 prize pool per round (50:50 split male / female), plus 100% payback		

Please Note: Merged Category awards / payouts will be awarded based on raced category. Rule 2.03.03a, will be applied for any competitor who does not start the final / last moto which means they will not qualify for event awards and series qualification rounds & points if applicable.

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Sprockets, Challenge, and Masters 30 + categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to secretarypineriversbmx@gmail.com
