


Drawing with light

Gear

- Camera with any wide-angle lens
 - manual mode or
 - bulb mode
- remote shutter release or Hahnel Capture
- Tripod
- Light source
- Dark clothing
- Torch or head lamp



Technical stuff



- **Aperture**
 - controls ‘brightness’ of the light tool
- **Shutter speed**
 - controls ambient light
- **ISO**
 - adds grunt: boosts exposure when light is limited



Shutter speed

A **shorter exposure** reduces ambient light, making the background darker.


A **longer exposure** (e.g. 20–30 seconds) allows more ambient light (like moonlight or streetlights) to enter.



Aperture

A **narrower aperture** (e.g. f/11) dims the light tool but increases sharpness and depth of field.

A **wider aperture** (e.g. f/2.8) makes the light tool appear **brighter** and more intense.
