Hello Flash and the board of SEA-PAH!

I was finally able to talk to Rose, my coat check lead, about y'all coming back to help run or totally run the coat check for SEAF 2024 and she would love to turn it back over to you. (She said her first love is box office.) If you would like to take on staffing the coat check for Friday evening and Saturday day and evening over the weekend of April 26-28, 2024, we would love to collaborate with you. Below are two different options for our organizations to work together. Please let me know if you would like to schedule a meeting to discuss which option works best for your organization.

**Option 1- Running coat check as a partner organization:**

- We would supply all the materials (racks, tickets, etc...) and collaborate with you on the size and location of coat check.
- SEA-PAH would be responsible for staffing coat check during: set-up on Thursday evening or Friday afternoon; all open hours on Friday and Saturday; packing up on Sunday between noon and 4pm.
- Volunteer shifts are usually in the 2-4 hour range. (Harder to fill time slots like closing hours are usually shorter.)
- All volunteer names must be emailed to SEAF staff one week in advance to be placed on the entry list.
- All SEA-PAH volunteers get all SEAF volunteer perks: access to the volunteer lounge, free entry to SEAF that day before and after their shift, swag, snacks during shift, invitation to the volunteer appreciation party.
- SEA-PAH is welcome to bring and post a sign announcing and promoting the organization. Exact signage size to be determined.
- SEA-PAH is responsible for collecting and handling all cash donations to coat check. (If you would like SEAF to supply a starting till, inform us before April 1st.)
- SEAF will provide SEA-PAH with an iPad to collect donations via credit cards. A check for all coat check donations via credit cards, minus 10% to cover bookkeeping and credit card fees, will be mailed to the organization 30 days after the event.

**Option 2- Helping to staff coat check:**

- SEA-PAH would encourage their members to sign up for coat check volunteer shifts during SEAF (all open hours on Friday and Saturday) through our volunteer portal.
- Volunteers perks: access to the volunteer lounge, free entry to SEAF that day before and after their shift, swag, snacks during shift, invitation to the volunteer appreciation party.
- SEA-PAH is welcome to bring and post a sign announcing and promoting the organization that can be fit on a tabletop sign holder (8.5"x11")
- All SEAF volunteers receive cash handling/credit card transaction training from SEAF staff and are responsible for collecting and handling all cash and credit card donations to coat check.
- A check for 50% of all coat check donations collected during any shift that had a SEA-PAH recruited volunteer will be mailed to the organization 30 days after the event.

Looping forward to having puppies, kitties, and other cute critters at SEAF again!
