BURSARY SELECTION CRITERIA 2019

CORE REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to apply, candidates must:

1. Be Australian citizens or permanent residents.
2. Be under the age of 30 (when the educational activity commences)

DESIRABLE ATTRIBUTES

The judging panel will look for the following attributes and qualities:

1. a strong academic record, ideally with a course weighted average mark of at least 70 percent or a proven record of excellence in the applicant's vocation
2. a genuine interest in the chosen educational activity and target country;
3. a genuine interest in international affairs and some awareness of the history and nature of relations between Australia and the candidate's target country;
4. a demonstrated awareness of how the educational activity may enhance the candidate's academic ability and/or further the candidate's career aspirations;
5. a demonstrated link between the candidate's chosen educational activity and the AIA objectives of 'promoting an interest in and understanding of international affairs'; and
6. strong communication and interpersonal skills that will allow the candidate to act as effective ambassadors for the Western Australian branch of the AIA.
