Committee Meeting Minutes

7 September 2017

Jupp Lane event

The City of Belmont is running the event again and the date has been set for the 17th of November. The City has employed a David Synder of “spacedout” to facilitate the event.

Felicity has met with him and Nelson (the City’s place activation officer) and the following is proposed:

- Garden stall (run by the Rivervale Community Growers)
- The Rivervale Primary School display in the laundrette
- Sam’s Butcher to do a BBQ on the street.
- Bollywood dancers by the Jannet Indian restaurant
- Community mural along Jupp lane.
- ECU students to undertake pop-up music performances.

New Logo

Determined that we need a new logo and the students from ECU have agreed to redesign. Felicity is to get a sketch and to chase up some designs hopefully by the start of October.

Publicity Liability and Insurances

Agreed that we need to get quotes. Alan and Ian to chase up contacts they have at other groups and try and seek quotes.

City of Belmont Community Contribution Grant

Agreed that we should apply for this grant for up to \$5000 for community groups. Several ideas were put forward including:

- Community notice board
- Outdoor cinema nights
- Fairy lights in trees along Kooyong Rd

Ian agreed to cost these and see if they can be included within the grant. Ian also agreed to write and submit the grant application.

City of Belmont Business Improvement Grant

Agreed that we should try and assist Rivervale IGA owner to apply for this grant (up to \$10,000) and investigate using it to fund the Jupp lane community mural. The aim is to finish the mural at the Jupp lane event and possibly use it to raise funds.

Ian agreed to assist Felicity in making this happen and help compile the grant application paperwork for the IGA owner.
