

Secretary Report

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At the end of 2025, the Curtin Christian Union finished its year off with a total of 44 members whether ordinary or associate members. As of a few weeks prior to the 2026 AGM we have 29 total members. While that is a percentage decrease of 34%, it is not uncommon for the club to have an influx of ordinary members join in the September-October period as we also had only 29 members as of September 2025 also. We had an exciting 96 expressions of interests (EOIs) this year with 80% of those EOIs from semester 1 open day.

In semester 1, we held 2-hour long fortnightly meetings for a total of 8 meetings. A lot of our committee meetings consisted of planning and reviewing different events, merch and our yearly campus connect in early semester 2. We, in preparation for Campus Connect, appointed another general member with a focus on campus connect and had one committee member step-down late into the semester also.

In semester 2, we switched to weekly 1-hour committee meetings totaling 7 meetings as of the time of this report. This consisted also on a lot of reviewing past events and planning our different event structures for 2027!

Our committee, outside the general executive roles was composed of four main teams: comms (or social media) team, prayer team, stalls team, and events team. Each committee member had a focus in at least one of these areas. We hope to continue this trend of many contacts next year at open-day and to separate roles and responsibilities in the committee in a similar manner next year.
