## PRESIDENT UPDATE

What a huge month it has been for the Club since our last Vikings Voice.

Back in October we launched a Club-wide survey to better understand what you, our members and families wanted to see from the future of the Vikings. Your feedback helped shape our new Vision, Values and Behaviours framework which we launched last month.

It has been fantastic to see how well it has been received. The framework is already being discussed across age groups, displayed throughout the Clubhouse and home change rooms, and shared across our social channels. It is an important step in strengthening the culture and direction of our Club.

Importantly, the survey did not just guide our culture. It also highlighted several practical improvements you wanted us to prioritise.

One of the clearest messages was the need to upgrade our canteen facility. I am pleased to say that in less than seven days we completed a fantastic makeover which has transformed the space. A big thank you to our project leaders Amy and Andy Gray and the many volunteers who stepped up with their time, skills and effort to make it happen.

Upgrading our field lights was another key priority identified in the survey. While we are not in a position to deliver that immediately, discussions are progressing well as we explore the best pathway to deliver this important upgrade later this year.

Soon we will also begin refreshing the downstairs bathrooms, another improvement highlighted by members as part of the survey feedback.

On the field the action has well and truly begun. Our Senior team under new coach Nick Duggan is making strong progress, with several exciting new signings bringing experience and depth to the squad. Their recent intra-club hit-out showed plenty of positive signs for the season ahead.

Across Youth and Senior teams there are several practice matches taking place in the coming weeks. Keep an eye on our social channels for details and come down to support the Vikings when you can.

As part of rolling out our Vision and Values framework, I am also pleased to announce a new initiative launching on April 1 — Vikings Volunteer of the Month.

Each month members of our community will be able to nominate a volunteer who has demonstrated one or more of our values: **belonging, respect, resilience, integrity** or **teamwork**. Nominations will be reviewed by the Committee, with one volunteer recognised each month.

Thanks to the generous support of Community Bank Wynnum Manly, each monthly winner from April through August will receive a \$200 cash award in recognition of their contribution to the Club. Keep an eye out for nomination links via the STACK Team App and future editions of Vikings Voice.

Finally, one of the other clear messages from the survey was the need for more consistent communication across the Club. We heard you.

That is why in 2026 the STACK Team App will be our primary communication platform across all areas of the Club. While we will continue to share updates via social media and email where appropriate, the Team App will be the main place to stay informed about teams, events and club updates.

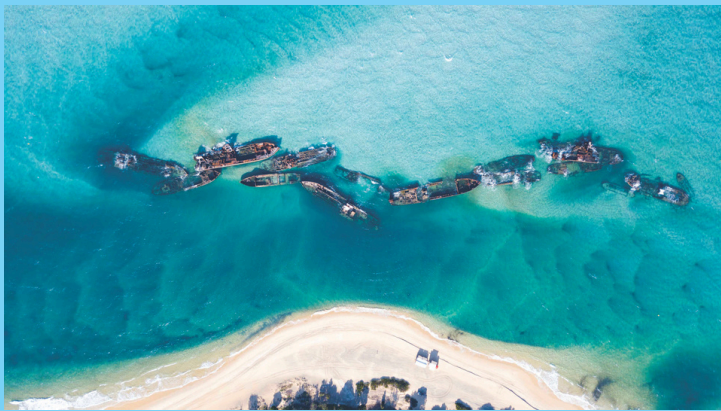

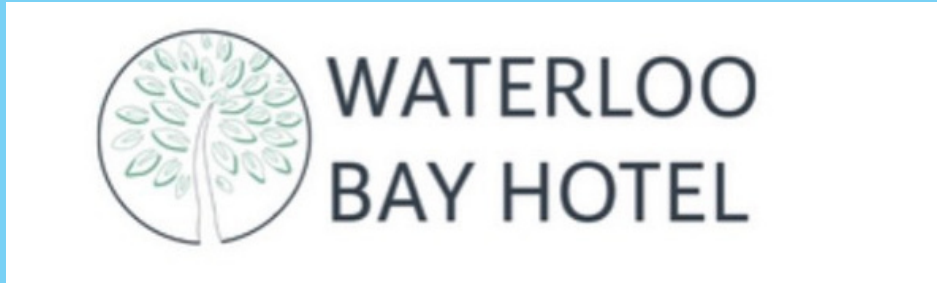

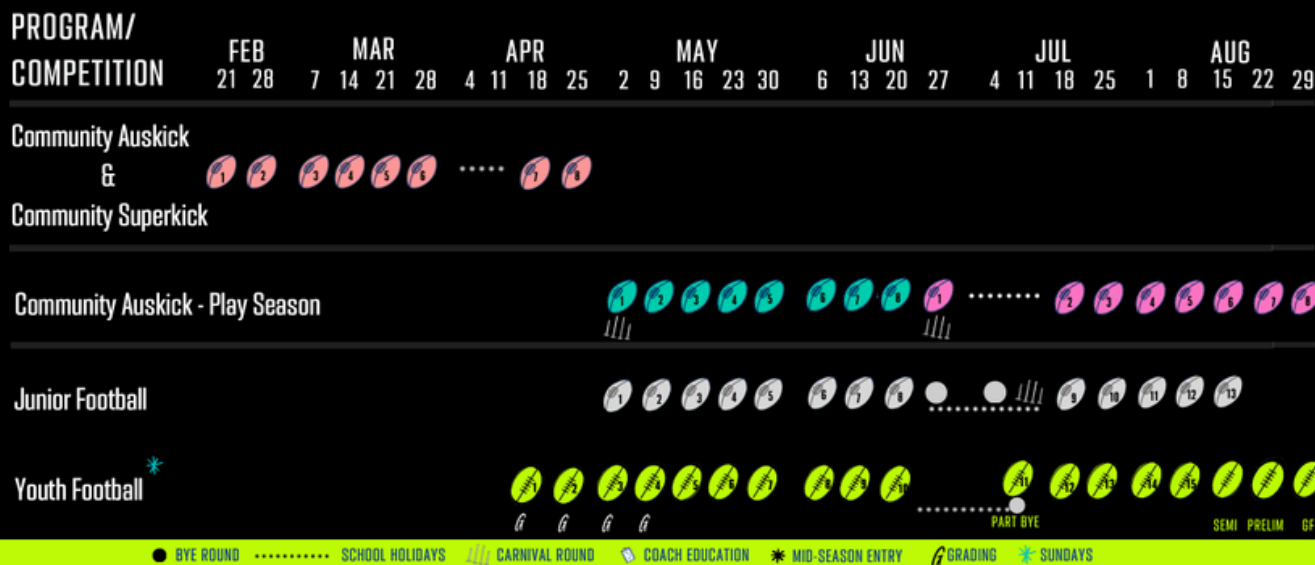
