OUR VISION AND FOCUS

Alongside the Executive and General Committee my vision is clear. To see the **Wynnum Vikings become a destination club**, one where players, coaches, volunteers, partners and the community choose to be part of because we provide the type of facilities, support, opportunities and culture people can thrive under. From someone wanting to try AFL for the first time to those who want to play at the highest level. A club where our success is not just measured by the scoreboard but our success off the field as well.

Our goal is to make the Vikings a true community hub for the Bayside, a place where football connects people, friendships are built, and everyone feels welcome.

To achieve this will take time and a united front. The work has already begun, and the energy, ideas, and intent across our new leadership team give me great confidence that we are moving in the right direction.

BUILDING THE RIGHT STRUCTURE

As part of our vision to become a destination club, one of the first things we identified was the need to have the **right roles**, **the right people**, **and the right level of support** across every area of the club. Getting this structure right is essential to how we operate and grow.

We are implementing new and shared roles across key areas to reduce loads and increase support. For example, next year we will have **two Junior and two Youth Coordinators**, will introduce a **Coach Coordinator for Juniors** and one for **Youth**, and have expanded our **Sponsorship Team from one to three members** to strengthen engagement with partners and community supporters.

Additionally, we have commenced advertising for **recruitment of a new Senior Coach for 2026** and to build out our **Senior Football Department** to ensure we have the right roles for support, growth, and success.

These changes build the framework for growth, yet it's the people who give their time and energy that make it all possible.

VOLUNTEERS - THE HEART OF OUR CLUB

Every season, more than **I 00 volunteers** keep our club running. From coaches to team managers, canteen helpers to our Executive and Committee Members, all generously donate their time in unpaid roles to help our players, families, and community thrive.

It's the generosity of these volunteers that not only keeps our fees affordable and the club operating smoothly, but also ensures every dollar of revenue is reinvested back into our programs, facilities, and future growth.

PATHWAY FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

On the field, our focus is on building strong, sustainable player pathways that create opportunities for everyone to develop and belong.

Our goal is to field teams across all mixed and boys' age groups from Auskick to Seniors, including the reintroduction of Under 17s in 2026.

Our girls' program continues to grow, and we aim to field teams from Auskick through Under 15s, with Under 17s and Women's Seniors to follow in coming years.

Recruitment and retention are key, so please register early and encourage friends, classmates, and neighbours to come and try AFL with the Vikings.

CLUB DEVELOPMENT AND FACILITIES

With Phase I of our clubhouse renovations now complete, we are planning the next stages of our 3 to 7 Year Club Development Plan, which includes:

- Upgraded **field lighting** to support night games and pathway programs
- Canteen upgrade
- Bathroom facilities improvements both downstairs and upstairs
- A new digital scoreboard
- Balcony extension with kitchen and bar service access
- A new timekeeper's box
- Driveway and carpark upgrades with improved lighting

These projects will not only benefit our club but will also strengthen our role as a **community hub**. Improved lighting, accessibility, and facilities mean more opportunities for local groups, families, and schools to enjoy and use the space.
